Converse County Request for 800 MHz channels

Discussion on request from Converse County for five 800 MHz channels for a new radio site at Glenrock. The Region 46 (Wyoming) 800 MHz plan is used to prioritize the use of the 800 MHz frequencies. Upon the review of the Region 46 800 MHz plan, the following channels have been assigned to Converse County:

Channel 12	851.1625 – 806.1625
Channel 35	851.4500 – 806.4500
Channel 92	852.2125 – 807.2125
Channel 112	852.4625 – 807.4625
Channel 136	852.7875 – 807.7875

Martin McCoy made a motion to submit channels 12, 35, 92, 112, and 136 to Converse County for presentation to their vendor for verification of use at the new 800 MHz site at Glenrock. If the vendor approves the list, then Converse County may start the licensing process. The motion was seconded by Mark Harshman. The motion passed on a voice vote.

Bob Symons will create a letter from the Region 46 800 MHz Regional Planning Committee to Converse County describing the actions of the RPC on November 17, 2014.

800 MHz channels usage at Casper Mountain

Mark Harshman stated that Casper has contracted with a frequency coordinator to find two replacement frequency pairs at Casper Mountain. There are 800 MHz channels assigned to Natrona County and many unassigned channels available for Natrona County , if needed. Bob Symons will forward the updated 800 MHz channel assignment list to Mark Harshman for the frequency coordinator to use for the replacement channels.

Laramie County

Laramie County is exploring adding two channels to the Fox Farm Site and adding a new seven channel site at Archer. The new site may be built within a year. The funding has not been authorized at this time. Upon the notification of Laramie County the Region 46 RPC may have a

phone meeting to approve frequencies. Bob Symons will be asking Colorado and Nebraska about the current 800 MHz usage within close proximity to the respective borders. This may reduce possible problems with the assignment of 800 MHz channels for Cheyenne.

Member Comments

Robert Wilson asked about the current version of the Region 46 800 MHz Channel Assignments. Bob Symons will be updating the Channel Assignment list including a date on the pages and identifying the channels which have been assigned.

The Region 46 800 MHz plan was provided to all of the members and guest for review and possible update at the next meeting.

Glen Crumpton made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Martin McCoy and passed on a voice vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:21 am.
