

**Region 46 – Wyoming**  
**800 MHz Regional Planning Committee**  
**November 13, 2006 Meeting**

Meeting Called to order by Mark Joiner, Special Liaison at 3:35 pm at the Holiday Inn by the River in Casper, Wyoming. The 800 MHz plan needs to be amended to allow for the election of a new chairman.

The proposed agenda was reviewed and being no changes it was approved.

The minutes for the November 14, 2005 meeting were reviewed. Motion by Craig Post to approve the November 14, 2005 minutes, seconded by Mark Harshman and approved by voice vote.

Discussion on the current 800 MHz transition. Because of interference between the public safety use and cell phone use, Nextel has submitted a plan for transitioning public safety users to a dedicated public safety spectrum block. Natrona County/Casper and Cheyenne Fire Department are currently in contract negotiations with Nextel to complete the transition. The Casper initial plan has been approved by Nextel. The transition plans should be completed in the spring of 2007. Only licensed 800 MHz users will be available for Nextel to pay for the transition.

Once the transition of the Natrona County/Casper and Cheyenne Fire Department allocations have been completed the Region 46 – 800 MHz plan will need to be revised to reflect the changes. During this process the 800 MHz plan will also be revised to include new officers.
