Interoperability Executive Committee Phone Conference Meeting September 8, 2008

Chairman Billy Janes called the Phone Conference meeting to order at 1:30 pm.

Members participating: Chairman Billy Janes, Marty McCoy, Jim Archerd, Dale Pawling Lanny Applegate, Mark Harshman, Danny Glick and Bob Symons.

WyoLink Applications

Discussion on the WyoLink applications that have been received since June, 2008. There are 26 new applications. The applications received are from Sheriff's Offices, School Districts, State Agencies, County Public Health Offices, Fire Departments and Transportation Security Administration. Bob Symons recommended the approval of all of the applications.

Lanny Applegate made a motion to recommend approval of the applications to the PSCC, seconded by Mark Harshman. The motion passed on a voice vote.

Dynamic Regrouping

Marty McCoy, WyoLink Support Manger, introduced a proposed PSCC policy on adding dynamic regrouping to all WyoLink talkgroup plans and code plugs. Dynamic regrouping allows for the WyoLink Support Office to regroup radios to another talkgroup, whether that new talkgroup is in the code plug or not. This is an important feature of WyoLink that may not be used but if needed could provide a very valuable service. Marty is checking on if this could be done through the dispatch centers.

Mark Harshman made a motion to recommend to the PSCC a policy that all radios using WyoLink have the dynamic regrouping talkgroup added to code plug. The motion was seconded by Dale Pawling. Motion passed on a voice vote.

Bob Symons informed the committee that Cheyenne Fire and Rescue has been cut-over to WyoLink and the 800 MHz to VHF connectivity is working well.

Being no further business, Chairman Janes adjourned the meeting at 1:40 pm.
